1	d	Emergency brakes	
2	a	After every working day.	
3	b	Water can freeze in cold weather and cause brake failure	
4	a	A supply pressure gauge	
5	c	Spring pressure	
6	d	3 psi in one minute	
7	c	Brake as hard as you can, get off the brakes when the wheels lock, get back on the brakes when the wheels start rolling again	
8	b	You have to push harder on the brake pedal to control your speed on a downgrade.	
9	a	Park on level ground, chock the wheels, and release the parking brakes.	
10	c	The one way check valve	
11	c	Release the brake when you are 5 M.P.H. below	
12	a	Service brake system	
13	c	S-cam drum	
14	b	An air pressure gauge to show the pressure available for braking.

16	a	Brake lag distance.
